

## Nomination Guidelines for Coordinators

#### Nomination deadlines:

Winter semester: 1<sup>st</sup> April until 1<sup>st</sup> May

Summer semester: 1st October until 1st November

#### **Application deadlines:**

Winter semester: 15<sup>th</sup> May

Summer semester: 15<sup>th</sup> November

#### How to nominate:

- 1. Please only use the attached Excel form for nominations. We cannot accept nominations in any other form.
- 2. The necessary information from your students are:
  - first name, last name
  - date of birth
  - gender
  - e-mail address
  - study programme at home
  - level of studies
  - duration of exchange (1 or 2 semesters)
  - desired study programme at Bayreuth (see program list in nomination form and note that study programme during exchange must be in coherence with study programme at home university)
- 3. Send the completed nomination form to:
  - incoming-exchange@uni-bayreuth.de
- 4. The University of Bayreuth will confirm the nomination and send out the application information to you and your students.

#### **Admission Requirements:**

- **Official nomination:** students must be officially nominated for the exchange programme by their home university.
- **Student status:** to be eligible to apply for the exchange programme, applicants must currently be enrolled as students at the home university.
- Academic Background: the exchange programme must be in coherence with the study programme at home university (i.e. a student from Biology cannot join the exchange programme for Law students).



- Language requirements: In general, we recommend all international students to have at least a <u>B2 level language proficiency in English or German</u> (depending on the language of instruction). This way, we want to ensure that all students will be able to follow the lectures taught. However, it is only required to upload a language certificate with the application for the following three programs at the University of Bayreuth:
  - Study of Religion (German or English)
  - English Studies (English)
  - o Law (German or English)

The University of Bayreuth accepts the following internationally recognized language certificates as proof of language proficiency:

#### For German:

- o Goethe Certificate, at least B2
- o TestDaF, at least 12 points, but no area below 3 points
- o Telc, at least B2

#### For English:

- o TOEFL, at least 75
- o IELTS, at least 5.5

## **EXCHANGE APPLICATION**

NOMINATION	In order to officially nominate students for the exchange programme, please fill out our Excel nomination form and send it back to us via e-mail to <a href="mailto:incoming-exchange@uni-bayreuth.de">incoming-exchange@uni-bayreuth.de</a> .
APPLICATION PROCESS	After the official nomination, students will receive an email containing all necessary information concerning the application procedure. UBT uses an online application form (MoveON). The link to the application portal will be sent to the students with the confirmation email.
APPLICATION DOCUMENTS	<ul> <li>The following documents are requested in the online form:</li> <li>copy of passport (or ID card)</li> <li>confirmation form signed by student and coordinator</li> <li>official transcript of records</li> <li>language certificate (if applicable)</li> <li>ERASMUS students only: provisional Learning Agreement signed by student and home university</li> <li>motivation letter</li> </ul>
ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS	<ul> <li>Official nomination: students must be officially nominated for the exchange programme by their home university.</li> <li>Student status: to be eligible to apply for the exchange programme, applicants must currently be enrolled as students at the home university.</li> <li>Academic background: the exchange programme must be in coherence with study programme at home university (i.e. a student from Biology cannot join the exchange programme for Law students).</li> <li>Language requirements: there are language requirements that apply to some study programmes (please see "language requirements" listed below).</li> </ul>
LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS	Generally, we advise all international students to have at least a B2 level language proficiency in English or German (depending on the language of instruction). However, it is only required to upload a language certificate with the application for the following three programs at the University of Bayreuth:  • Study of Religion (German or English) • English Studies (English) • Law (German or English)  Accepted language certificates:  For German: • Goethe Certificate, at least B2 • TestDaF, at least 12 points, but no area below 3 points • Telc, at least B2  For English: • TOEFL, at least 75 • IELTS, at least 5.5
ADMISSION	Admission letters will be sent out via e-mail by the student administration office ( <a href="mailto:studierendenkanzlei@uni-bayreuth.de">studierendenkanzlei@uni-bayreuth.de</a> ) approximately 4-6 weeks after the end of the application period.

ACCOMODATION	If students wish to apply for a room in our student dormitories, they need to fill in the online application form of the <a href="Studentenwerk Oberfranken (SWO)">Studentenwerk Oberfranken (SWO)</a> .  The International Office cannot guarantee a place in a dormitory. The regional Association for Student Affairs (SWO) is a third-party provider and responsible for allocating rooms in the student dormitory. COURSE CATALOGUE	On our <u>cmlife</u> platform students can browse for courses (e.g. by faculty, study programme and language of instruction).  Exchange students at UBT are <u>free to choose</u> from all available courses. Please note however, that the exchange nomination, application and admission the University of Bayreuth <u>must be in coherence</u> with the study programme at the home institution.  As the University of Bayreuth always tries to provide up-to-date learning experiences with new and interesting topics, the final course catalogue for each semester is only available shortly before the beginning of the semester (winter semester courses - from end of August/beginning of September, summer semester courses - from end of January/beginning of February). Previous semesters can be used as a reference.
GERMAN LANGUAGE COURSES	Preparatory German language courses (fee-based) will be held by the IIK Bayreuth (Institute for International Communication and Foreign Cultural Exchange), an institute linked to the university. Please visit the <u>IIK website</u> for more detailed information or contact our <u>Welcome Services</u> .  Students will also have the opportunity to attend free German courses at our <u>Sprachenzentrum (Language Center)</u> once they enroll at the University of Bayreuth.
ARRIVAL AND FIRST STEPS IN BAYREUTH	Our Welcome Services will guide you through arrival planning as well as your first steps in Bayreuth.
